December tenth is Garrison's 100th birthday. There will be celebrations in various churches. Suggest this to such churches as have not arranged such celebrations and if possible see that in each church celebration there is a Niagara Movement man to speak and to give the meeting the practical turn of taking a firm stand for National aid to Negro education.

Secretaries of standing committees are being appointed and will be announced in December. Enclosed is the treasurer's reminder—please acknowledge it by letter to Mr. Jackson immediately, either by cash or promise. The Niagara Movement is now represented in 26 states. Do you know anybody of Niagara bias to recommend for membership in Indian Territory, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Nebraska, Oklahoma or South Carolina? Can you suggest any special work in your own locality which our organization ought to undertake?

The Niagara Movement will be represented by a special delegation at the final interment of Albion Tourgee at Mayville, N.Y., Nov. 13.
