Electronic Resource Use Policy

The UMass Amherst Libraries has guidelines for use of electronic resources, as does UMass Amherst Information Technology. The Libraries subscribe to electronic resources, most of which are licensed, not owned, by the Libraries for use by students, faculty, and staff for study and research purposes.

The owners of each electronic resource define what they consider to be appropriate use, and they monitor use to detect potential abuse of their intellectual property. Misuse or violation of these restrictions may result in the termination of access to the electronic resource for the entire UMass Amherst campus.

By using electronic resources licensed by the UMass Amherst Libraries, users agree they will comply with applicable terms and conditions.

Users agree that they will:

- Use the electronic resource only for non-commercial, educational or research purposes
- Respect all copyright, trademark, patent, or other intellectual property right associated with the electronic resource
- Seek appropriate permissions when using the electronic resource in course packs or e-reserves
- No systematic downloading of content
- No use or access by non-authorized users, including sharing passwords or access codes
- Do not use the electronic resource in an illegal or otherwise unauthorized manner
